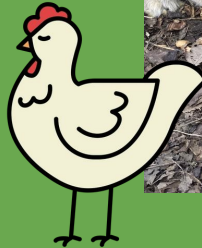


FARM SCHOOL

This hands-on approach promotes deeper understanding and retention of knowledge. Farm school emphasizes building a strong connection with the natural world, fostering a sense of respect and responsibility for the environment and animals living in it. In essence, farm school provides a rich and stimulating environment where young children can learn and grow through direct interaction with the natural world.

COOKING CLUB

School Readiness

School readiness sessions allow children to learn foundational skills through play and exploration. Books are a part of every school Readiness session, and the children enjoy a range of stories and non-fiction with Lauren. Together they learn to anticipate events within stories, develop language and expand their vocabulary. Our outdoor learning manager Lauren runs small group games such as sorting natural materials where children are taught addition, subtraction and subitising. We provide a range of resources such as numicon boards and number sticks to teach one-to-one correspondence when counting. We also make transient art where children can investigate shapes, sizes and patterns.

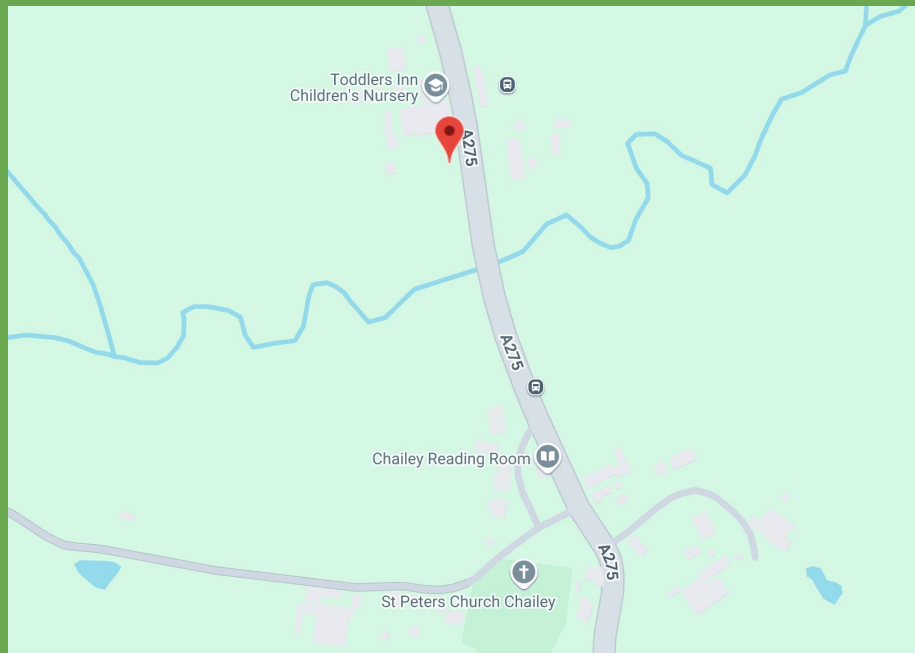


At Toddlers Inn, we take time to listen to the children, their ideas and interests. They are encouraged to make choices, explore freely and follow whatever sparks their curiosity.
